The season of singing has come, the cooing of doves is heard in our land.


The fig tree forms its early fruit; The blossoming vines spread their fragrance.

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ. Ephesians 1:3

This verse was part of the inspiration for Thomas Ken to write "Praise God From Whom All Blessings Flow." Thomas Ken was known as "England's first hymnist" before John Wesley or Issac Watts. After becoming ordained into the ministry Thomas became the chaplain at Winchester College. At this time only the Psalms were sung in public worship. Thomas felt the boys of the college needed something more to encourage devotional habits. He wrote three hymns for the boys to sing in private. One for morning, one in the evening and the third at midnight if they were not asleep. All three hymns ended with the common stanza which became the most widely sung verse in the world.

Although the word doxology is not found in the Bible, the themes expressed are certainly scriptural.

For of him, and through him, and to him, are all things: to him be glory forever. Romans 11:36

Unto him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Ephesians 3:21

Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost. Matthew 28:19

The doxology is an expression of praise to God for ALL our many blessings including spiritual, emotional, physical, financial, etc. I am thankful AFUMC continues to sing the doxology each Sunday. We have countless blessings for which to praise our God.
